As a new member of staff, you may have new ideas that could have a positive impact.


Heres some examples:

- Wall art, physiotherapy equipment and chairs were purchased for the Wellness room on Ward 2. All equipment is over and above what the NHS is able to usually provide.
- Young Adult rooms have been implemented on Ward 1, 2 and 4 including Smart TV's and game stations to help young patients feel more at home.
- Mindfulness 'Train the trainer' sessions were rolled out to staff across the organisation to help ensure we can give Mindfulness sessions to staff whenever we need to.

- Evidence that this is something additional to the NHS standard or something which is not normally funded through NHS budgets (if you're not sure, just ask!)
















OUR DONATION PROCESS

Please take note of this process. You will be required to take action should a patient or member of the public wish to donate.









PENNIES FROM HEAVEN

I donate 38p a month

An easy, simple way to support an enhanced experience for patients.

What is Pennies from Heaven?

- Quite simply, your net salary is rounded down to the nearest pound with the spare pennies donated to charity.
- The Royal Orthopaedic Hospital NHS Foundation Trust has chosen to donate its Pennies from Heaven to our Trust Charity.
- The most you can give per payslip is £0.99.
- All donations are eligible for gift aid which means an additional 28% is added by the government at no additional cost to you.

All you have to do is complete the application form and the extra few pennies will be automatically deducted from your payslip. It is a simple, tax efficient and regular way for you to participate in charitable giving.
